

4. BUSINESS ARISING FROM PLANNING BOARD
  1. Plan and Bylaw Review Project
    - a. Keith let council know the details of the process. There had been only one submission and Review Committee met on July 18<sup>th</sup> to assess the submission and make recommendation.
    - b. The recommendation from Review Committee was to accept the proposal as it scored well on the criteria set forth in the RFP
    - c. Motion to award contract to Brighter Community Planning and Consulting was made by Tory Kennedy, seconded by Darlene MacDonald. Motion carried.
5. Development Report
  1. Mirko's current development report was presented to Council.
  2. Keith let council know he planned on having a meeting with the Provincial Permitting department to clarify regulations on development and subdivision permits, specifically access issues.

  1. Details on current balances were presented to council.
7. Other Business Discussed
  - A. Excavation Pit Bylaw
    1. Keith gave the timeline on the submission of the bylaw amendment, expecting approval, likely in early September
    2. The potential for an application was discussed. At the time, there were no valid applications on file.
    3. There was discussion on what bylaw would be applicable if an application came forth before the new bylaw was approved by the Minister. As there were no current applications on file, the matter was put off until an application was received of the bylaw was approved.
